AUCTION OF TOLL FREE NUMBERS IN THE 833 CODE 44 APPLICANTS QUALIFIED TO BID IN 833 AUCTION

FCC AU Docket No. 19-101

1. By this Public Notice, Somos identifies 44 applicants found to be qualified to bid in the auction of certain Toll Free numbers in the 833 code (833 Auction). The 833 Auction, which is scheduled to take place on December 17, 2019, makes available 17,638 Toll Free numbers in the 833 code. This Public Notice also addresses the continuing obligations for all 833 Auction applicants, including those not qualified to bid. It also contains bidding procedures and other important information regarding the 833 Auction.

I. QUALIFIED AND NON-QUALIFIED BIDDERS

2. The applications to participate in the 833 Auction have been reviewed for completeness and compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC or Commission) rules and procedures. The applicants have been classified into the two categories set forth below:

Qualified	44 applicants
Non-Qualified	16 applicants

3. **Qualified Bidders.** Attachment A to this Public Notice lists the name of each of the 44 qualified bidders. Designation of an applicant as qualified to bid in this auction indicates that the applicant has provided the certifications and information concerning its qualifications for participation in the auction, as required by the Commission's 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice, and that it timely submitted a sufficient upfront payment.³ Each qualified bidder must maintain the accuracy of its auction application.⁴

- 4. In order to participate effectively in the auction, each qualified bidder should carefully review the auction rules, procedures, and other information described in 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice.⁵ This Public Notice, which provides additional guidance for qualified bidders, and other documents related to the 833 Auction are available at <u>auction.somos.com</u>.
- 5. **Non-Qualified Applicants.** Attachment B to this Public Notice lists each applicant that submitted an application to participate in the 833 Auction but did not qualify to bid. All applicants in the 833 Auction, including those that have been deemed not qualified to bid, remain subject to the Commission's prohibition on certain communications in connection with the 833 Auction.⁶

II. BIDDING INFORMATION

A. Bidding Round

- 6. The 833 Auction will take place on **TUESDAY**, **DECEMBER 17**, **2019**, **starting at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time (ET) and closing at 6:00 p.m. ET.** No bids will be accepted before or after this period.
- 7. For more information on bidding in the 833 Auction, see the 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice and the bidding instructions and bidding tutorial provided at auction.somos.com.⁷

B. Bidding Contingency Plan

- 8. Prior to the start of the auction, each bidder should develop comprehensive contingency plans that can be quickly implemented in case difficulties arise when participating in the auction. While Somos will correct any problems within Somos-controlled facilities, each bidder is solely responsible for anticipating and overcoming problems such as bidder computer failures or other technical issues; loss of or problems with data connections, telephone service, or power; adverse local weather conditions; or unavailability of its authorized bidders. Each qualified bidder is solely responsible for ensuring that only authorized bidders place bids on its behalf.
- 9. A qualified bidder should ensure that each of its authorized bidders can access and place bids in the Somos Auction System,8 without relying upon the same computer. Contingency plans will ideally include arrangements for accessing and placing bids in the Somos Auction System from one or more alternative locations.

III. POST BIDDING INFORMATION

- 10. Winning bids will be announced via public notice (Winning Bidders Public Notice) posted at <u>auction.somos.com</u>. The Winning Bidders Public Notice will also include the final payment due (or refund) for each bidder and instructions on how to make final payments.9
- 11. Final payments will be due 10 business days after the Winning Bidders Public Notice is released. A winning bidder may make its final payment within five additional business days after the applicable deadline, provided it also pays a late fee of 5% of the winning bid.
- 12. Any potential subscriber that directly participates in the 833 Auction and is a winning bidder must declare within 15 business days after the Winning Bidders Public Notice is released the name of the Responsible Organization (RespOrg) it will use to reserve the Toll Free number in the Toll Free Database.

IV. EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS, BIDDING WEBINAR, AND MOCK AUCTION

A. Educational Materials

13. Bidding instructions and a bidding tutorial are available at <u>auction.somos.com</u>. 10 We strongly encourage qualified bidders to read the instructions and access the tutorial prior to participating in the mock auction.

B. Bidding Webinar

14. A webinar on the 833 Auction bidding will be held on Thursday December 12, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. ET. All qualified bidders will be emailed invitations to the bidding webinar. The bidding webinar will be recorded and available at auction.somos.com.11

C. Mock Auction

- 15. All qualified bidders are strongly encouraged to participate in the mock auction. The mock auction will occur on Friday, December 13, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. ET. Only qualified bidders may participate in the mock auction. Moreover, only someone listed as an authorized bidder in the applicant's FCC Form 833 can upload a bid file for that applicant in the mock auction.

V. APPLICANTS' CONTINUING OBLIGATIONS

A. Duty to Maintain Accurate Information in Applications

- 17. We remind applicants that 833 Auction procedures require an applicant to maintain the accuracy and completeness of information furnished in its pending application to participate in the 833 Auction.¹³ Each applicant should amend its application to furnish additional or corrected information within five days of a significant occurrence, or no more than five days after the applicant becomes aware of the need for amendment.¹⁴ All changes are subject to review by Somos staff.
- 18. After release of this Public Notice, an applicant that needs to make permissible minor changes to its auction application or that must make changes in order to maintain the accuracy and completeness of its application must submit a letter briefly summarizing the changes to its application by email to auctionhelp@somos.com following the instructions provided in the 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice. 15
- 19. For more information on an applicant's continuing obligation to maintain the accuracy and completeness of information furnished in its application to participate in the 833 Auction, applicants should refer to the 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice.¹⁶

B. Due Diligence

20. We remind each potential bidder that it is solely responsible for investigating and evaluating all legal, technical, and marketplace factors and risks associated with the Toll Free numbers that it is seeking in the 833 Auction.¹⁷ Each potential bidder must undertake its own assessment of the relevance and importance of information gathered as part of its due diligence efforts.

C. Prohibition of Certain Communications

21. We remind all 833 Auction applicants that the prohibition on certain communications applies to each applicant that filed an application (FCC Form 833) in the 833 Auction. Specifically, each applicant in the 833 Auction is prohibited from cooperating or collaborating with any other applicant with respect to its own, or one another's, or any other competing applicant's bids or bidding strategies. Each applicant will be prohibited from communicating, with any other applicant in any manner, the substance of its own, or one another's, or any other competing applicant's bids or bidding strategies (including with respect

to the post-auction market for Toll Free numbers).¹⁹ For purposes of the prohibition on certain communications, an "applicant" in the 833 Auction includes: (i) all controlling interests in the entity submitting the auction application; (ii) all holders of partnership and other ownership interests and any stock interest amounting to 10% or more of the entity, or outstanding stock, or outstanding voting stock of the entity submitting the auction application; (iii) all officers and directors of that entity; and (iv) any entity listed as a potential subscriber on whose behalf the entity submitting the auction application will be bidding.²⁰

- This prohibition took effect as of the auction application filing deadline, which was **Friday**, **October 18**, **2019**, **at 6:00 p.m. ET**, and ends at the post-auction final payment with late fee deadline for the 833 Auction, which will be announced in a future public notice. ²¹ **This prohibition applies to all applicants regardless of whether such applicants become qualified bidders or actually bid in the 833 Auction. ²² For further information on the prohibition, applicants should refer to the 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice. ²³**
- 23. Reporting Obligations. Each auction applicant that makes or receives a communication that appears to violate the prohibition on certain communications must report the communication in writing to the Commission and Somos staff immediately, but in no case later than five business days after the communication occurs. An applicant must report such a communication even if it does not result in an agreement or understanding regarding bids or bidding strategy that must be reported pursuant to the applicant's obligation to maintain the accuracy of its application. Each applicant's obligation to report any such communication continues beyond the five-day period after the communication is made, even if the report is not made within the five-day period. Each applicant auction applicant is made, even if the report is not
- 24. Reporting Prohibited Communication. A party reporting any information or communication that appears to violate the prohibition on certain communications must take care to ensure that any report does not itself violate the prohibition.²⁷ To minimize the risk of inadvertent dissemination of information in such reports, parties reporting a potential

prohibited communication must submit a report directly to the following individuals: (1) Margaret W. Wiener, Chief, Auctions Division, Office of Economics and Analytics, FCC, by email to 833auction@fcc.gov; and (2) Joel Bernstein, Vice President, Regulatory and Public Policy, Somos, by email to auctionhelp@somos.com. For the 833 Auction, any such report must be filed according to the instructions set forth in the 833 Auction Procedures Public Notice. 28

25. Possible Sanctions. Any applicant found to have violated the prohibition on certain communications may be subject to sanctions.²⁹ In addition, we remind each applicant that it is subject to the antitrust laws, which are designed to prevent anti-competitive behavior in the marketplace. If an applicant is found to have violated the antitrust laws or the Commission's rules in connection with its participation in the competitive bidding process, it may be subject to forfeiture of its upfront payment, or full bid amount, and it may be prohibited from participating in future auctions, among other sanctions.³⁰

D. Limited Information Procedures

- 26. We remind applicants that, under the limited information procedures in effect for the 833 Auction (sometimes also referred to as anonymous bidding), Somos and the Commission are withholding from public release, until after the close of bidding in the 833 Auction, any information that may indicate specific applicants' interests in the auction—including, among other things, the numbers that an applicant selects for bidding in its auction application, the amount of any upfront payment made by or on behalf of an applicant for the 833 Auction, any applicant's bidding eligibility, and any other bidding-related information that might reveal the identity of the bidder placing a bid or the amount of the bid.³¹
- 27. Accordingly, communication with other applicants or public disclosure of such non-public information may violate the Commission's limited information procedures and the prohibition on certain communications. Therefore, applicants must take care not to communicate non-public information to the public, financial analysts, or the press.³² Examples of communications raising concern, given the limited information procedures in effect for the 833 Auction, would include an applicant's statement to the press about its upfront payment or bidding eligibility, and an applicant's statement to the press that it is or is not interested in bidding in the auction.

E. Submission of Auction-Related Filings

- 28. A party wishing to submit a request, a complaint, or other information concerning the 833 Auction should, in addition to following other procedures prescribed by the Commission's rules, send a copy by email to 833auction@fcc.gov to the attention of Margaret Wiener, Chief, Auctions Division, Office of Economics and Analytics, FCC, and to auctionhelp@somos.com to the attention of Joel Bernstein, Vice President, Regulatory and Public Policy, Somos.
- 29. During FCC auctions, the Commission occasionally receives complaints regarding specific bidders and requests to suspend bidding during an auction. The Commission has explained that, while it reserves the right to take appropriate action during an auction to preserve the integrity of the auction process, it is generally the Commission's practice to address any such allegations only after the close of the bidding, when there is greater opportunity for investigation of such allegations, if warranted.33 Moreover, the Commission has stated that it will not investigate any complaints or allegations that are not accompanied by full contact information, including name, address, and telephone number, for the complaining party or parties.34
